PTM

A parent teacher meeting is held on the Second Saturday of every month for the convenience of the parents to meet the teachers and evaluate the progress of their child. It is advised that parents should attend without fail.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- · Extracurricular activities like sports, drama, elocution and many other spheres are always among the priorities.
- · Social activities like field trips, visit to museums, art galleries, interschool events etc. are also encouraged in our school.
- Annual day / sports day is an excellent platform to explore the child's leadership qualities.

INSTRUCTION TO PARENTS

Parents are requested to familiarize about the regulations laid down by the school management mentioned in the school diary.

An application for admission after child must be given in advance.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

Birth certificate to be produced at the time of I standard admission.

Regulation I: Nursery admissions-New application

Regulation II: Admissions for Class I - mandatory admission (either a student from nursery campus of Newton or any other school)

Regulation III: Admission for higher classes (i.e II std to X std - Transfer certificate from recognised school should be included along with application in case if the child is from other school)

Any fees collected once are non refundable.

CHECKLIST - ITEMS SUPPLIED FROM THE SCHOOL (POST ADMISSION)

- Tie, badge, belt and socks will be supplied in the school.
- · Uniform will be issued in the school.
- Notebooks, textbooks and other stationary will be supplied in the school.

FEES GUIDELINES

- All parents are requested to pay monthly fees for the period of 12 months on or before 16th of every month.
- Fee for the month of April/May will be collected in the month of December and January respectively. Fees for the month of October will be collected in the month of September.
- 16th the last date for the payment of monthly fee.
- Post 16th, a fine of Rs. 5/-per day will be charged till 30th of every month.
- If fee is not paid for three consecutive months, the name of the student will be removed from the enrolment register, which leads to re admission process (if the child wishes to continue).
- Maintenance fees, library, medical expenses, laboratory and the two-term exam fees will be collected.
- · Annual day fee will be collected during the occasion
- T.C will be issued to only those students whose fees are cleared up to date.
- Ensure to collect the fee receipts for future reference.

BOOKS

- Books fees should be paid in advance.
- Books will be issued by the school post payment of book fees.

PARENT GUIDELINES

- Parents are requested to arrange for books and send their children along with the books, on the re-opening day of the school, so that it enables the child to follow the syllabus in time.
- If children come to school without books and stationary, they will not be permitted to sit in the class.

 Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities to maintain punctuality and discipline.

Parents need to follow up their child in the daily homework and also take active part in

helping for the school activities for which the child has participated.

 Parents/guardians are requested to check the school diary for any assigned homework for the day and ensure to countersign the same for regular updates.

- If homework is not assigned or if the child is unable to follow the lesson you may contact the Head Mistress of the school regarding the same, for any alternatives.
- · Any parents whose wish to suggest their opinion or review can use the dedicated column provided in the diary.
- Parents / guardians are not allowed to meet the students and teachers, Parents can meet the class teacher and subject teacher during class hours. only on the second Saturday of every month between 10:00 AM and 12:00 noon. Parents are requested not to disturb the teachers or go to the class directly during the school hours.
- In case of emergency parents can meet the principal or H.M and take their ward.
- · Please send the lunch bags with the child along the morning arrival of the children.
- · In any case, the child forgets to bring lunch or exercise books you can hand it over to the security at the main gate by writing in a slip the name of the student, class and section. Arrangement will be made to hand over to your child before the lunch break.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE REGULATIONS

- · A child should attend the school for at least 210 days till 30th March to be eligible for the Final exam.
- · No leave absence is granted except when applied for in writing by the parents/ guardians giving genome reasons for the absence.
- · Prior approval must be taken from the principal or H.M for leave of more than three days.
- Irregular attendance is not entertained.
- Repeated absence without prior intimation for more than 7 days is liable to result in the name of the pupil being removed off the rolls.
- Re-admission in such case may be granted.
- Parents picking up their children from the school during working hours on any grounds will do so at their own risk.

 Student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a doctor's certificate. He/she must observe the prescribed period before returning to class.

NOTE

- Teachers are not responsible if the students belongings are lost or damaged in the school premises.
- Parents are requested not to send their child with any valuables. The school authorities are not responsible for any loss or damage in the school.

PROMOTION RULES

- The minimum pass percentage in each subject is 40%.
- Any student absent for reasons other than medical ground in any of the test or exam, will be detained in the particular test or exam.
- One who fails to appear for the final examination for any reason shall not be promoted
 to the next higher class even if he or she secured sufficient marks in other tests or
 examinations.
- Re-test or re-exam will not be conducted for absentees or failed candidates.
- The progress reports will be given to parents for perusal and signature on open house days, on which the report cards are given.
- The parents must sign in the presence of class teacher, if the parent fails to come on that day kindly not that it will not be sent through the child on any cost.
- In case progress card is lost by the parent/student a fine of Rs. 250/- will be charged for issuing a new report card, a letter from parents/guardians must be submitted as a request.
- For the students of VII and X, they will be allowed to sit for Board Examination only
 on the basis of result of preparatory examination, students will only be permitted on a
 request from the parents in case of under average students and it is on their own risk.
- Students those who have repeated the same class for second time will not be admitted
 to the school.
- Co-operation of parents will help their child to maintain regularity in home assignments and regular attendance in the tests will better the performance of the child, without need of private tuitions.
- · Parents requested to supervise the studies of their children regularly.
- No explanation will be accepted if any of the above mentioned instructions are not followed strictly.
